

Brucellosis is an infectious disease caused by bacterium of the genus *Brucella*. Various *Brucella* species affect sheep, goats, cattle, pigs, dogs, and other animals. In infected ruminants, brucellosis commonly causes abortion during the second half of gestation. In the US, the most common infectious causes of sheep abortion are chlamydia (enzootic abortion, EAE) and *Campylobacter* spp. (vibriosis). Toxoplasmosis is also a common cause of ovine abortion. Less common causes include bluetongue, border disease, brucellosis, Cache valley virus, listeriosis, and salmonellosis.
